Dr. Manbok Jeong is currently the section head of Veterinary Ophthalmology at the Royal Animal Referral Center, Seoul, Korea. He obtained a BS degree from the College of Veterinary Medicine, Chonnam National University in 2001 and went on to complete an MS from the Department of Veterinary Clinical Sciences, College of Veterinary Medicine, Konkuk University in 2003 and PhD from the College of Veterinary Medicine, Graduate School, Seoul National University in 2008. He has extensive research and clinical experience having worked as a postdoctoral fellow at the Laboratory of Comparative Ophthalmology, College of Veterinary Medicine, University of Missouri as well as Department of Veterinary Clinical Sciences, Iowa State University, and a research professor at the Seoul National University. He became a De facto Diplomate in the Asian College of Veterinary Ophthalmologists in 2013. He has published numerous papers in peer reviewed journals largely in the field of veterinary ophthalmology. Some of his research interests include electrophysiology of retinal cells and comparative aspects of clinical retinal disease in humans and animals.
